

Minnesota voters will have the chance to decide the future of marriage on November 6, 2012

The **Minnesota Marriage Protection Amendment**, which asks voters *“Shall the Minnesota constitution be amended to provide that only a union of one man and one woman shall be valid or recognized as a marriage in Minnesota?”* places the traditional definition of marriage – one man and one woman – into our state constitution.

It is essential for all voters to vote YES on November 6th as Minnesota law requires ballot questions that are left blank to be counted as NO votes.

Take the pledge to vote YES on the Marriage Protection Amendment today.

The failure to vote is the same as voting NO.
